

#### **GENERAL SERVICE**


enables AA to function as a whole (GSO, AAWS, AA GV, GSB)



Late 1940's Bill & Others developed AA Service Structure 1955 St. Louis Convention –Mantel of leadership passed to the Fellowship










## Why Do We Need A Conference?





- October- Area Assembly












